STANDARDS & PROCEDURES

Students & school personnel who manifest flu-like symptoms are advised not to report to school. Symptom monitoring is recommended. Seek medical consult if needed.

For those in school who develop a temperature of 37.5°C or higher during the day will be further evaluated in the Isolation Room. Antigen tests will be done.

If the test shows a positive result, the student or staff member will be sent home immediately. Quarantine and Isolation will be



SAFETY PROTOCOLS

1. Physical distancing (at least 1 meter apart)
2. Wash hands regularly with soap & water for 20 seconds
3. Wearing of well-fitted masks
4. Checking of temperature upon arrival
5. Proper disposal of infectious waste
6. Routine sanitation & disinfection
7. Do not share personal classroom supplies with others
8. Use of air purifiers
9. Use of Isolation area for testing & evaluation

observed until the individual feels better and tests negative.

Parents shall report to the school if their child experiences flu-like symptoms. Symptoms need to be monitored and testing will be done if needed.

In the event of class quarantine, all students shall revert to distance learning. The school will ensure the continuity of teaching & learning in line with the school's contingency plans.

QUARANTINE

Staying away from the others if exposed & had close contacts with a confirmed case.

ISOLATION

Have been infected & tested positive regardless of vaccination status

CLEARANCE FOR A SAFE RETURN TO SCHOOL

Upon return to school, the concerned teacher, personnel, or student shall present a clearance/medical certificate issued by a healthcare professional.
